

HOW TO USE YOUR MINI CAMPER

Front cab

Our mini campers are all automatic. In the cab you will find everything you would expect in a luxury car. Satellite navigation, cruise control, and a full Bluetooth system.

Camper alarm

Located on the driver's door is two buttons one with a padlock open and one with the padlock closed. Press the button with the closed Padlock at night to lock the doors from the outside.

If you use the button on the keys to lock the van you will set the alarm off during the night.

Raising the roof

The best way to pop the roof is to sit in the front seats. Press the clasp and thread the straps through on both sides. Then push up on the roof. Once the roof is up you will see the roof bed platform. This can be pushed up to create more headroom.

When you bring the roof down you need to bring the roof bed down first. Then slowly start lowering the roof using the straps, as you are lowering the straps ensure all the canvas material is pulled inside the vehicle. Secure by pulling the straps tight. Make sure this is done properly before driving off. The canvas should always be dry when the roof is closed. This prevents damp stains forming on the canvas. If the roof is closed when the canvas is damp, please open the roof as soon as possible to allow the canvas to dry. Open the roof occasionally to allow the canvas to air if the roof has not been used for a long period.

The roof bellows could leak rainwater if heavy gusts of wind are combined with heavy showers. They are not able to provide full protection in extreme weather conditions. To prevent water entering the vehicle, you should close the pop-up roof in bad weather.

Fuel

The fuel filling point is located on the passenger side towards the back end of the vehicle. To open this cap, simply press on the opposite side of the cap allowing the cap to open fully before inserting the fuel nozzle.

You can also see a blue cap, which is for Adblue, you most likely will not have to refill this. However, if you do see the Adblue message pop up on your dashboard you need to contact the office for more information.

Our campers are handed over to you with a full tank of fuel and must be returned back to us full.

IMPORTANT

All of the campers and motorhomes are DIESEL.

Water

To top up the water in the camper you must fill up the water container located in the cupboard under the sink. When topping this container up you must unscrew the lid and take out the pump that is located inside the water container. Once this container has been filled up it is then ready to be put back into the under sink cupboard with the pump being replaced back into the container and the lid being firmly screwed back on.

Gas

The gas compartment is located internally toward the back of the vehicle at the far end of the kitchen unit. This can only be located with the boot open. There is two black clips at the top and bottom of the door for the gas compartment, simply turn these to open door. There is a tap on top of the gas bottle, turn this to open gas supply. There is also a yellow valve connected to the gas pipe, this must be turned in line with the pipe to enable the gas to get through
